---

In what did an angel of the Lord appear to Joseph?  
A. A dream (2:19)

---

In Matthew chapter 2, what was Joseph doing each time an angel appeared to him?  
A. Sleeping (2:13; 19)

---

Who appeared in a dream to Joseph in Egypt?  
A. An angel of the Lord (2:19)

---

Why did an angel tell Joseph to return to Israel?  
A. For those who were trying to take the child's life are dead (2:20)

---

Take whom and go to the land of Israel?  
A. The child and his mother (2:20)

---

Who are dead?  
A. Those who were trying to take the child's life (2:20)

---

Why are you to go to the land of Israel?  
A. For those who were trying to take the child's life are dead (2:20)

---

A. The child and his mother (2:21)
